3-Point TOWING-BRIDLE

For Inflatable Boats and Dinghies

Your Towing-Bridle comes completely assembled and ready to use. The 3-Point Towing-Bridle is designed for Inflatable boats and tenders the have (2) towing rings and (1) bow eye.

Here are some tips for the proper use and attachment of your new 3-Point Towing-Bridle:

- 1. Snap the two stainless steel 'snap hooks' from the non-adjustable legs to the Towing Eyes on the bow of the dinghy.
- 2. Snap the stainless steel 'snap hook' from the adjustable leg to the center bow eye. Adjust the leg to ensure even pulling with the (2) non adjustable legs.
- 3. Next, a Towing Line must be rigged to run from the port stern cleat, through the stainless Towing Ring (at the opposite end of the snap hook legs), and back to the starboard stern cleat.
- 4. At the Towing Ring on the Bridle, secure the line with a knot then run each end of the towing line to the aft corner cleats as described above. This will prevent the dinghy from continual sliding on the ring while under tow.
- 5. After affixing the Towing Line to the two stern cleats, you will have formed an 'X-shaped' bridle of this Towing-Bridle and your towing line. By towing in this fashion, the Inflatable will track straighter and safer than with a single towing line led to a single towing ring on the bow.
- 6. The preferred distance to tow an inflatable or tender is 1 to 1 1/2 boat lengths behind the mother ship. As you slow down, the yellow float will prevent the bridle from sinking into the prop of the boat, but be vigilant of its location and if necessary haul in the towing line to shorten the distance to the inflatable or tender.
- CAUTIONS: A) For added security while towing, a painter, tied from the dinghy bow to the mother ship and slightly slack, will serve as a lazy safety line. This practice is highly recommended for all towing situations.
 - B) Never tow a dinghy by the large lifting handle at the bow. Always attach the bridle to properly installed towing rings, and add a safety painter as mentioned above.
